

## NOTICE REGARDING TRANSFER OF ASSETS FOR NURSING HOME BENEFITS

Your application for nursing home benefits has been denied because you transferred assets without receiving fair market value for the assets, per OAC 317:35-19-20(5). You transferred \$\frac{113,573,65}{10}\$ in assets and are not eligible for nursing home benefits for \$\frac{792}{200}\$ days. You are not eligible from \$\frac{05/13/2015}{200}\$ to \$\frac{07/122017}{200}\$. If the transferred assets are returned to you or you receive commensurate return (fair market value) for them, you may become eligible for nursing home care. You are eligible for other SoonerCare (Medicaid) services.

If you feel this denial will result in an undue hardship for you, an undue hardship waiver may be requested within 30 calendar days of the date of this notice. Undue hardship exists when you would be deprived of medical care such that your health or life would be endangered or you would be deprived of food, clothing, shelter, or other necessities of life. You may be required to pursue legal action to return the transferred assets to you in order to receive the undue hardship waiver. You will be notified of the decision regarding a request for an undue hardship waiver within 30 calendar days of our receipt of all required information. Send your request for an undue hardship waiver to the local OKDHS office shown on this notice.

If you disagree with the decision on your request for an undue hardship waiver, you or your authorized representative may appeal the decision by requesting a hearing at the local OKDHS office. Forms to request a fair hearing are available from the local OKDHS office. Any request for a hearing must be made within 30 calendar days. The period to request a hearing begins with the date of the decision of the undue hardship waiver. You have the right to legal counsel at the hearing. Information about where you can get free legal help is available on request from the local OKDHS office or you may choose your own private attorney. If you need assistance completing the forms or preparing for a hearing, contact the local OKDHS office or your attorney.
